THE 3-DAY CURSILLO

The Cursillos in Christianity is a method which enables living the true Christian life in the light of the baptismal commitment. It offers a way to facilitate an encounter with what is fundamental of Christian living.

To experience a Cursillo is a marvelous grace, which takes individuals as they are, with all their possible situations, and enables them to cooperate with God. It helps them to obtain or continue a conversion, and enables them to join their lives more fully to God, and to constantly move toward sanctity in communion with their brothers and sisters.

It can be said that a Cursillo is "the joyful proclamation of being Christian." Such a joyful expression brings a proclamation of doctrine, participation in Christian community living, and the human element or situations in which these take place.
