A Stewardship Moment Solemnity of the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist June 23/24

Today we celebrate the birth of St. John the Baptist. This prophet, who practiced austerity in the desert, proclaimed the kingdom of God, a coming judgment, and baptism as a sign of repentance. With profound humility, John directed attention not to himself but to Jesus. John's attitude was, "He must increase, I must decrease" (John 3:30). John's birth, days after the summer solstice when daylight hours

begin to decrease, contrasts with Jesus birth days after winter solstice heralding daylight's increase. Like John the

Baptist, stewards turn attention away from themselves and towards Jesus. The stewardship question for us is whether or not we our-



selves are prepared to "decrease" and allow Jesus to "increase" in our hearts, minds, words and actions.

CURSILLO TERMS

Cursillo—"Cursillo" means "short course" or "little course." The full title of the Cursillo is "A Short Course in Living What is Fundamental for Being Christian". Because this is the name by which everyone knows the movement, and because this is the name that is used internationally, even in countries where Spanish is not spoken, this word is not translated into English.

Ultreya—The Spanish word "Ultreya" means "keep on going" or "onward". It is the word the medieval pilgrims used when they were on their way to the shrine of St. James at Compostela. They would shout "Ultreya" as a cry of encouragement. In the Cursillo literature it is used to refer to the weekly gathering of all the group reunions and all Cursillistas; the place where they come together to encourage each other to keep on going.

All Cursillistas are welcome to attend Holy Spirit's Ultreya Group where we meet on Monday evenings to support and encourage one another to become "The Good News".
