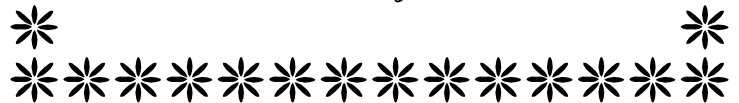

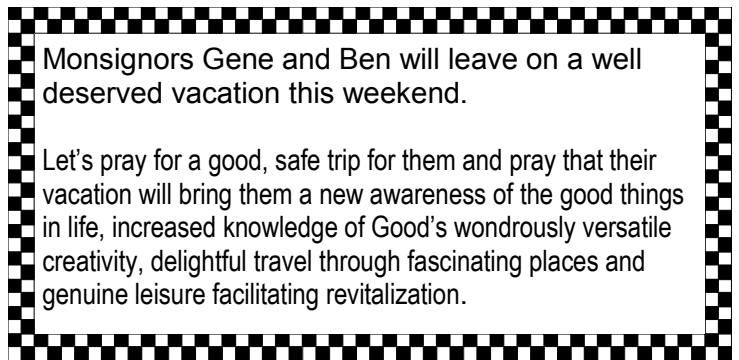

General Principles: Word & Testimony

"Go into the whole world and proclaim the good news to all creation". (Mk. 16:15). This is the Lord's commandment. Cursillos were not created to demonstrate the power of the Word, or to stress the need for proclaiming it, but to deliver it in such a way as to elicit a personal response. The Cursillo tries to illuminate all of life with the light of the whole Gospel.

To be effective, the Gospel should be proclaimed in the style that Christ exemplified. The Word has to be a living experience, since Christ is the Word made flesh. The Cursillos follow this style, based on the search for conversion in life's experience, and based also on personal and community witness of living what is proclaimed.
