CURSILLO

What is fundamental for being a Christian -"What is fundamental for being a Christian" translates the Spanish term "lo fundamental Cristiano." It refers to the core or nucleus of the Christian message, the essence of Christianity, that which has to be the basis of everything else in the Christian life: the love to God and love of neighbor—Jesus Christ and the life of grace. The whole Cursillo method is designed to make it possible for a person to live what is fundamental for being a Christian, and the weekend retreat is a short course in it.
