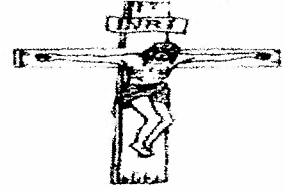

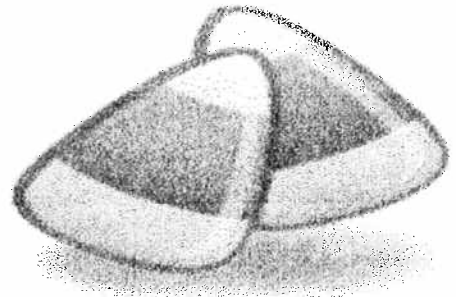
Support our Youth
