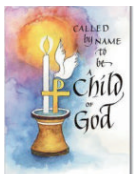

Labor of Love Service Project

My name is Eliza Cerda. I am a parishioner of Holy Spirit. During this Lenten Season I will be working on a project called Labor of Love. If you've been pondering who you would bless this Lent with almsgiving, perhaps you might pray about a local network. This project will support our Nurturing Network with supplies they need most to help mothers in crisis pregnancies. 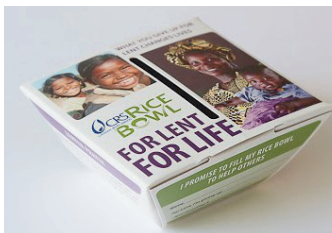

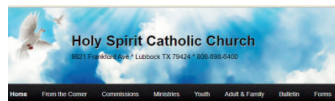

How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the **physically or mentally ill** including individuals suffering from **chronic illnesses** such as **diabetes**. Also excluded are **pregnant or nursing women**.

13th Anniversary of Pope Francis' Election




On March 13th, we celebrate the eighth anniversary of Pope Francis' election! Say a prayer for the Holy Father.

March 12th—Feast Day of Saint Luigi Orione 1872-1940

The founder of The Little Work of Divine Providence, which encompasses two active and two contemplative religious orders for men and women as well as a lay movement, was born in Italy's Piedmont. After early sojourns with Franciscans and Salesians, he entered the seminary of the Diocese of Tortona and was ordained in 1895. Always devoted to the care of others, especially the poor and sick, Don Orione established schools and learning centers, worker hostels, hospitals, and homes for the elderly, disabled, sick and blind. The members of his apostolate serve today in 300 foundations in Europe, Asia, Africa and North and South America. The dying words of this priest, who was canonized in 2004, were "Jesus ... Jesus... Jesus."

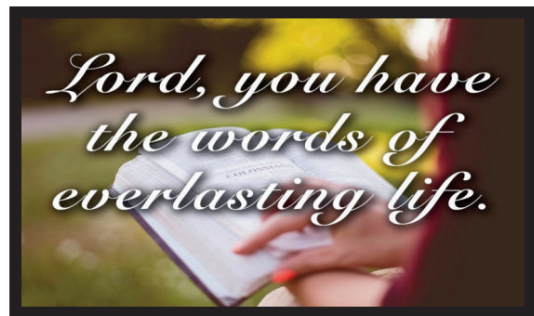
