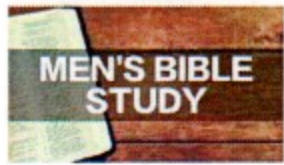
Choice Wine: 7 Steps to an Abundant Marriage

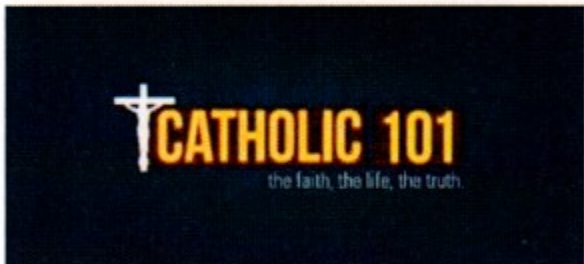
Holy Spirit Women's Bible Study
