I am talking about the loss of a loved one, or even the people who hurt us with there hatred of us. What makes it worse is your are in prison when your, mom or brother or sister dies. You are in prison and separated from your children who need you in their lives. And it just plain breaks your heart. I suppose that many of you can feel Michael's pain and anger at the situation. So let's look and what happened to us when we became Christians, God said; Ezekiel 11:18-20 "They will enter it and remove all its atrocities and abominations. ¹⁹ And I will give them another heart and a new spirit I will put within them. From their bodies I will remove the hearts of stone, and give them hearts of flesh, ²⁰ so that they walk according to my statutes, taking care to keep my ordinances. Thus they will be my people, and I will be their God." When we gave our hearts to God as Michael has, then we have a heart of Flesh not stone. If you walk with the devil you can do all kinds of evil things and not feel bad or care about anything or anyone you hurt. I suppose we have all walked with the devil at some time in our lives. So Michael's sister who was a good Christian woman is a saint in heaven with Jesus. She has not pain only joy and peace in her heart. 1 Corinthians 2:9 But as it is written: "What eye has not seen, and ear has not heard, and what has not entered the human heart, what God has prepared for those who love him."
