





The Parish Office Manager/Secretary position is open. This is a full time (32 or more hours), salaried position with eligibility for Diocesan health insurance. Job requirements include ability to work well with staff, ministry leaders and volunteers while understanding the need for confidentiality. Organizational skills as well as computer and typing skills are necessary. Working knowledge of Word, PowerPoint, Excel and Publisher are required. Job duties are directed by the pastor and include: welcoming and directing parishioners and visitors in the office; answering the phone and directing calls and messages as necessary; responding to parish emails in a timely manner; maintain parish calendar and assist with scheduling appointments, baptisms, funerals, weddings, special events, and meetings; assist in preparing parish bulletin as needed; general correspondence in both written and digital formats; monitor and order supplies as directed; data entry into church databases; other tasks as directed by the pastor.

The secretary reports directly to the pastor and job evaluation will be made by pastor at least yearly.




