1347-1380

**Mystic, Virgin, & Doctor of the Church**

**Feast Day: April 29th**

**Patronage: Fire Prevention, Nurses, Italy and Europe**



From a young age she had mystical visions of Jesus, Mary, and the saints. She became a Third Order Dominican and at the age of 21 had an experience she described as her “mystical marriage to Christ.” She often visited the sick in hospitals and served the poor. She was instrumental in restoring the Papacy to Rome. *The Dialogue* was her definitive work and she received the stigmata. Died at the age of 33.
