



Divine Mercy Sunday

April 27th

The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed at 2:45 PM in the Sanctuary.

How can I receive the "extraordinary grace" of Divine Mercy Sunday, which is the "complete forgiveness of sins and punishment?"

"The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

(Jesus' words to St. Faustina - St. Faustina's Diary 699) "Used with permission of the Marian Fathers of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Stockbridge, MA USA."

The condition to receive this *extraordinary grace* is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or at the Vigil celebration). "Worthily" involves making a good confession beforehand (during Lent), staying in a state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.

Can I receive a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday in addition to the extraordinary grace?

Yes! To encourage the faithful to practice mercy, Pope St. John Paul II decreed that the faithful can receive a plenary indulgence to offer for a soul in purgatory. This is in addition to the extraordinary grace one receives for him or herself.

The condition for receiving the plenary indulgence:

Take part in the prayers and devotions held in honor of Divine Mercy in any church or chapel, in a spirit that is completely detached from the affection for any sin, even a venial sin.

OR in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament, exposed or reserved in the tabernacle, recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus (for example, "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!").

Establishing Divine Mercy Sunday for the Entire Church

In 1981, Pope John Paul II said, "Right from the beginning of my ministry in St. Peter's See in Rome, I consider this message [of Divine Mercy] my special task. Providence has assigned it to me in the present situation of man, the Church and the world. It could be said that precisely this situation assigned that message to me as my task before God." Both in his teaching and personal life, St. Pope John Paul II strove to live and teach the message of Divine Mercy. When he canonized Sr. Faustina (making her St. Faustina) on April 30, 2000, he also, on the same day, surprised the entire world by establishing Divine Mercy Sunday (the feast day associated with the message) as a feast day for the entire Church. The feast day falls on the Second Sunday of the Easter season. On that day, John Paul II declared, "This is the happiest day of my life." -thedivinemercy.org

Pope John Paul II, the great Mercy Pope, died on April 2, 2005, the Vigil of Divine Mercy Sunday that year.


